## Payment

### Individual Payment Schedule

6. There are a number of ways you can pay your fees:
  - 6.1. Annually: payable on or before 30 September
  - 6.2. By semester: 2 equal instalments on 30 September and 30 January
  - 6.3. Monthly: 8 equal instalments starting in September and ending in April

The University can, on request, supply students who have accepted an offer of a place with an individual payment schedule, taking into account any preferred method of payment and any external and internal financial support that may apply.
