1. Programmes Delivered in Partnership with New College of the Humanities

Buddy Programme – Two day including a university visit to develop subject knowledge and learn more about university life.

Primary FOCUS Graduation - Primary FOCUS Week - Year 6 students take part in a fun and interactive week based at their IntoUniversity centre solely around a University subject and graduate from the week with a visit to a University.

Primary FOCUS Transition - Year 6 visit a University for the first time (only applicable if they weren't able to during their FOCUS week) and learn about how uni students found transitioning to new environments and learn about the skills that will be helpful to them when transitioning to Secondary school.
